**RESOLUTION No. 34/2026  
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE  
of 27 May 2026**

**on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school**

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

**positively evaluates the quality of education**

at the Doctoral School

run by

the Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 10 September 2025.

Justification:

On 28 November 2025, the Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology submitted a self-assessment report for evaluation regarding the quality of education at the Doctoral School run by the Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology from 1 October 2019, to 10 September 2025. The Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the self-assessment report and requested supplementary information from the Doctoral School on 18 February 2026. The supplementary information to the self-assessment report was submitted by the entity on 2 March 2026. The Evaluation Team then conducted an on-site visit to the Doctoral School on 25 March 2026, during which it obtained additional information allowing for a full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team found the Doctoral School's organization to be transparent, with clearly defined recruitment procedures, study paths, and a system for monitoring doctoral student progress. The mid-term evaluation was reliable and transparent, and the process itself was well-organized. The quality of research and teaching, as well as the selection of lecturers at the doctoral school and supervisors, enabled the achievement of learning outcomes appropriate to level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework. The high level of staff qualifications, access to research infrastructure, and the adaptation of curricula and assessment of learning outcomes translated into high quality of the education process. The Evaluation Team appreciated the Doctoral School's efforts in developing sound procedures, high educational standards, and improving staff competences. The systematic collection of feedback from doctoral students, the flexibility of the education, and good administrative support also deserved recognition.

Therefore, the Evaluation Team positively assessed the quality of education at the Doctoral School run by the Bydgoszcz University of Science and Technology during the period under evaluation.

After reviewing the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
